

2010 Acushnet Annual Boys Basketball Tournament

The Acushnet Youth Athletic Association would like to invite you to our Annual Boys Basketball Tournament for grades 3 through 8. The 6th, 7th and 8th grade tournament will run from Friday, February 5th through Sunday, February 7th. The 3rd, 4th and 5th grade tournament will run from Friday, February 12th through Sunday, February 14th. The registration fee will be \$200 per team, which guarantees you 3 games of pool play. Trophies will be awarded to Champions and Runner-ups of each division. We will have a full concession area. Please no outside food in our cafeteria. All games will be played at Ford Middle School & Acushnet Elementary School.

Rules

Teams must come from town recreational leagues only. NO AAU or Boy's Club teams are allowed. Teams may have a maximum of 12 players and 3 coaches. No roster changes are allowed after the 1st game. Teams must have 5 players at the start of each game or they will forfeit. No rescheduling of games. All rules of the "National Federation of State High School Association" will be followed except for the following:

Game Duration

3rd, 4th & 5th Grades – Two 16 Minute Halves

6th, 7th & 8th Grades – Two 16 Minute Halves

***Running clock except last 2 minutes of game & overtime.

Backcourt Defense

3rd, 4th Grades – Allowed last 2 minutes of game & overtime only.

5th Grade – Allowed 2nd half & overtime only.

6th, 7th & 8th Grades – No Restrictions except no teams can press when up by 15 points.

***Backcourt Defense Violation – 1st warning, 2nd technical foul.

General Rules

1. The clock will stop on all foul shots and time outs.
2. Each team will have 2 time outs per half. (1 in overtime). (no carryovers)
3. Overtime will be 2 minutes until one team wins.
4. Bonus begins on 7th Team Foul in each half.
5. Double Bonus begins on 10th Team Foul in each half.
6. Player fouls out with 5 fouls. (Technical Fouls count as personal fouls)
7. Coaches & Players are ejected from game after 2 Technical fouls and must sit down the next game.
8. A Player or Coach ejected for Vulgarity or Fighting will be ejected from Tournament. ***NO EXCEPTIONS
9. 3rd, 4th Grades will use a 28.5 Ball; 5th, 6th, 7th & 8th Grades will use a regulation ball.
10. 3rd, 4th & 5th Grades – No 3 pointers; 6th, 7th & 8th Grades – 3 pointers count.
11. Tie Breakers – 1. Head to Head 2. Points against 3. Points for 4. Coin toss
12. No outside balls allowed in gym. We will supply warm-up and game balls.
13. *****ANY CHILD WHO HAS BEEN KEPT BACK AT SOME TIME DURING HIS ACADEMIC HISTORY MUST PLAY UP WITH THE APPROPRIOTE GRADE LEVEL. Birthdates should fall as follows: 3rd grade – 9/1/00 to 9/30/01; 4th grade – 9/1/99 to 9/30/00; 5th grade – 9/1/98 to 9/30/99; 6th grade – 9/1/97 to 9/30/98; 7th grade – 9/1/96 to 9/30/97; 8th grade – 9/1/95 to 9/30/96. ***Birth Certificates are to be presented to Tournament Directors before your first game. All Rosters must be mailed in with check.**
